AAPS Scholarships and Grants

The Association of Applied Paleontological Sciences (AAPS), is a non-profit organization of primarily professional commercial paleontologists promoting science. AAPS offers two \$1000 scholarships to graduate level students in paleontology attending universities worldwide and two \$1000 research grants. All of the scholarships and research grants are awarded to the applicants by a majority vote of the membership attending our annual meeting in Tucson every February. Each scholarship and grant is awarded to students and researchers who qualify and meet the approval of the board of directors, along with a majority of the membership. Applications for these programs must be received by **December 1st** to be considered by the membership the following year.

James R. Welch Scholarship

The James R. Welch Scholarship is awarded to graduate level students who study and work on macro invertebrate fossils. AAPS initiated this scholarship in 1990 in order to encourage students interested in paleontological invertebrate studies.

Charles Sternberg Scholarship

The Charles Sternberg Scholarship is awarded to graduate level students who study and work on macro vertebrate fossils. AAPS initiated this scholarship in 1991 in order to offer encouragement to students in vertebrate studies.

A. Allen Graffham Research Grant

The \$1,000 Grant, is awarded to a select researcher that publishes on specimens collected by, or in collaboration with, AAPS members. AAPS offers this research grant annually to a scientist, researcher, or student in paleontology.

René M. Vandervelde Research Grant

The \$1000 Grant is available to qualified researchers working on the marine paleontology, geology, or stratigraphy of the Late Cretaceous Pierre and Bearpaw Shales of North America. Through this grant, Korite® International hopes to encourage scientific research and publications on the fauna from these deposits.

Dan Rigel Memorial Educational Grant

This grant worth up to \$1,000 will be awarded to a High School teacher(s) or High School educator to promote the education of their students in geology and paleontology.

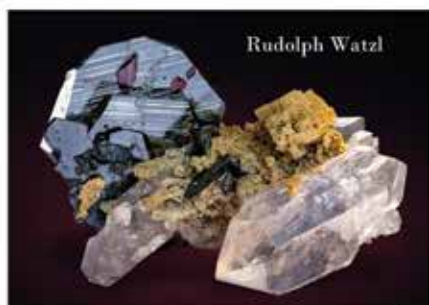

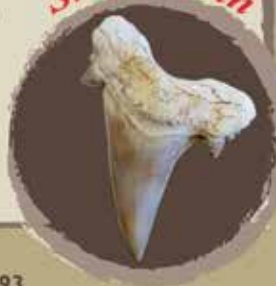

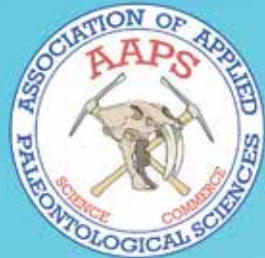

“THE PRESERVATION OF ORGANIC REMAINS”

When animals and plants die they for the most part decompose – their bodies are recycled. The dinosaur may have left its trackway across a mudflat ; the juniper drowned by a rising alkaline lake is only known by the impression of its bark in a broken cyanobacteria mold. These are icnofossils, and they reveal only a hint of the former living organisms.

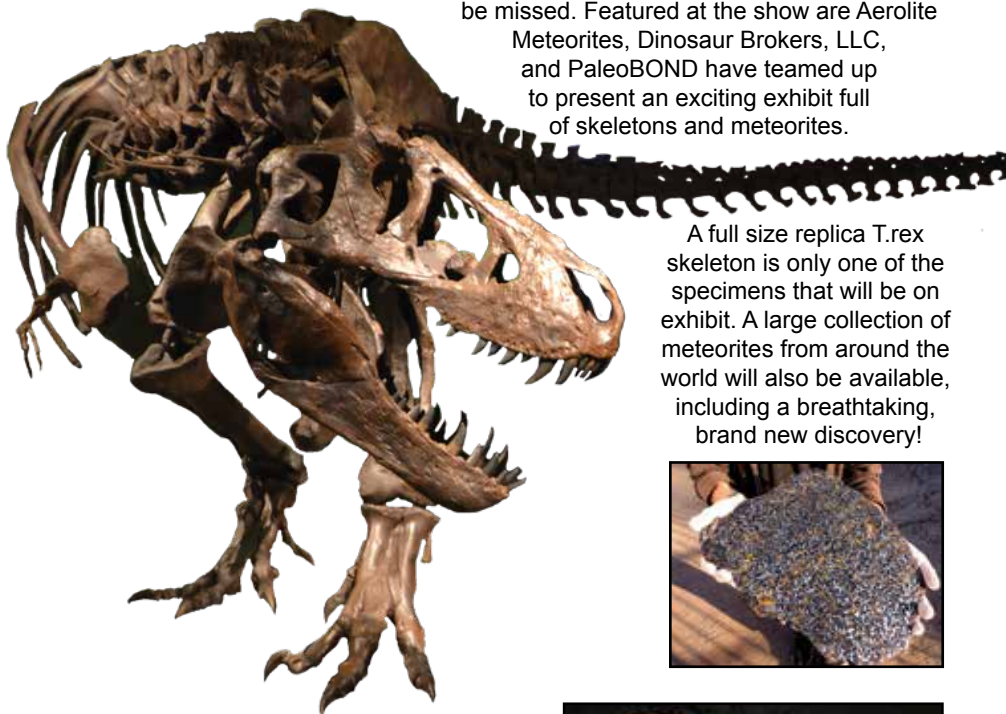

WHAT TO SEE IN 2018

The addition of the new Showcase Tent at the 22nd Street Show is a good example of what shouldn't be missed. Featured at the show are Aerolite Meteorites, Dinosaur Brokers, LLC, and PaleoBOND have teamed up to present an exciting exhibit full of skeletons and meteorites.



A full size replica T.rex skeleton is only one of the specimens that will be on exhibit. A large collection of meteorites from around the world will also be available, including a breathtaking, brand new discovery!



You'll also be able to see this incredible Oredont skeleton with parts of three different fetuses. It was collected from the White River Badlands near Douglas, WY. Final preparation was done by Warfield Fossils any you can see it in the ballroom at the Hotel Tucson City Center.



Be sure to check out the largest known Chisternon undatum (turtle) from the Green River Formation. It's 100% all natural, no restoration whatsoever on the specimen. It can be viewed at Lindgren Fossils located in the ballroom at the Hotel Tucson City Center.

AAPS ADVOCATE 2017-2018



During the 2017 annual meeting and auction in Tucson, Neal Larson recommended that we honor the person or company that successfully bids on the PaleoBOND Lab Coat. The lab coat was donated by Bill Mason during the 1995 AAPS auction and has been auctioned off every year since. The coat has been signed by guest speakers and visiting paleontologists each year. The winner has the coat for one year, and is required to bring it back the following year to be auctioned again. This year, the first recipient of the AAPS Advocate recognition is Bill Murray of PaleoTools®.

Bill began like most of us, with an interest in fossil collecting and preparation, early on he was bitten by the paleo bug. Fortunately for Bill, he and his wife Jane are residents of Utah, the state with more dinosaur species discoveries than all the other states combined. They enjoyed both the search and discovery of these ancient treasures. Bill discovered a Hadrosaurid dinosaur during 1995 and assisted with the collection and preparation of the specimen (collected by the University of Utah). It was during the preparation of these fossils that he realized the short-comings of the tools available to preparators.

It was apparent to Bill, that the air scribes on the market were not fossil friendly, they were developed to be used for engraving, not removing matrix from delicate fossils. He modified the Chicago Pneumatics' weak tips by manufacturing carbide replacements that removed matrix more efficiently, and lasted longer than the factory originals. As he continued to work on fossils, and word of his new modified carbide tips spread, demand increased, and Murray Engineering was born. By 1998, both bushings and styluses up to 4 inches long were available for the Chicago Pneumatic.

All the work at this point, was done out of the garage attached to their family home. Early the following year, Bill introduced stylus setups for both

the ARO and Ingersoll Rand (EP50). Testing of the new products was done by both academic and commercial fossil preparators, and Bill used their feedback to modify and improve his products. Murray Engineering became PaleoTools® and the company has been growing its product line ever since.

While both the Chicago Pneumatics and AROs were becoming familiar to fossil preparators across the country and around the world, many were not

happy with the way the tools handled. Bill designed a new smaller air scribe, with even finer styluses, that were easier to control for delicate preparation. The Micro-Jack® was introduced. These became Micro-Jacks® 1-6 which are some of the smallest, and most accurate air-tools available. They are designed for exquisite fossil perforation. As the number increase, so does the volume of air driving the stylus. The Micro-Jack® 1 & 2 are designed for work under a microscope. Micro-Jack 1 has a stylus that is .046" in diameter, being 1/3 smaller in diameter than the standard Micro-Jack®, which means you can get into tighter places with this tool.

By 2000, Bill and Jane were attending commercial fossil shows and the annual Society of Vertebrate Paleontologists meetings, letting show attendees view and test PaleoTools' products. Not only did the staff offer instruction, but they intently listened to feedback from scientists and preparators, and adjusted their product line to include new items as demand grew.

Since 2005, PaleoTools® has been the distributor for Crystal Mark, Inc., and carries the Swam-Blaster Micro Abrasive Blasters. As with all their tools and parts, staff will demonstrate the air abrasive unit for you at their booth. PaleoTools® has expanded their line to include replacement parts not only for the tools they manufacture, but they offer full service repair for most of the air scribes available to fossil perpetrators today.



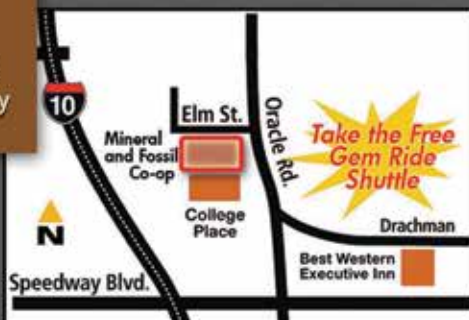

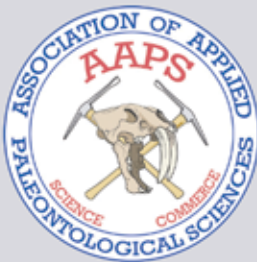

States Banning the Sale of Fossil Ivory

Because of the poaching of African Elephants for their ivory tusks, many countries have banned the import of modern ivory. Smugglers have been marking shipments as fossil ivory to get it past customs. Here in the United States, beginning with New Jersey and New York, state legislators began submitting bills to ban the sale of all ivory, modern and fossil. As a service to commercial fossil dealers, we are listing the states with fossil ivory legislation. When setting up at shows in these states, be very careful not to pack any Fossil Ivory, Mammoth Teeth, or products made from ivory as you risk losing them.

- California, effective July 1, 2016, Includes Mammoth and Mastodon Tusks and Teeth
- Hawaii, effective January 1, 2016, Includes Mammoth Tusks, Teeth, Bones and fur. Any Part.
- New Jersey, effective October 2014, Includes Mammoth Tusks and Teeth
- New York, effective June 30, 2015, Includes Mammoth Ivory

California has the most restrictive ban, and Sale or Sell means selling, trading, bartering for monetary or nonmonetary consideration or giving away in conjunction with commercial transactions. Ivory means a tooth or tusk from a species of elephant, hippopotamus, Mammoth, Mastodon, Walrus, Warthog, Whale or Narwhal, or a piece thereof, whether raw ivory or worked ivory, and includes products containing Fossil Ivory.
